1. **What is the 3rd Asia Leadership Forum Online all about? What is the aim of the event, the profile of speakers, theme and topics of the sessions?**

Aim and Theme

- With the theme, "The World After COVID: Leading Adaptively Beyond the Crisis," the Asia Leadership Forum is a unique online gathering on November 16-21, that brings together thought leaders from Harvard University and international practitioners.
- The program is dedicated to helping leaders initiate change and manage progress in their organizations and communities during these uncertain times. We hope that participants can use this forum to help reinvent themselves and their organizations for a more hopeful future.

Speakers

- World-renowned speakers from Harvard University and other world-leading institutions, along with industry practitioners from Asia, will present and engage with audiences on these topics:

- Global technology, business, and social megatrends in the COVID era;
- Case studies and lessons on how societies have overcome crisis;
- How to build organizations that adapt during times of crises;
- How to be a source of inspiration and mobilization through strategic communications;

Registration

1. How can I register for the event?

- You may choose between the "Basic Pass" (USD \$39) or the "Premium Pass" (USD \$49)

2. What are the differences between Basic Pass and Premium Pass? What are the benefits?

- The "Basic Pass" provides you access to sessions on Nov 16-20 (Mon to Fri), with 5 hours of on-demand access for one-year.
- The "Premium Pass" provides you access to all of the sessions on Nov 16-21 (Mon to Sat), 5 hours of on-demand access for one-year, 5 hours of live roundtable and Q&A with speakers, and 3 hours of roundtable discussions with international speakers, networking with Harvard speakers and authors, and a Certificate of Attendance signed by Harvard Faculty.

3. What if the person who registered can't make it on the event, can s/he be replaced by someone else?

- We will provide you with on-demand access to recorded sessions for one year even if you can't attend the session. The access link will be sent to you after the Forum.

During The Forum

1. Where will the Forum happen on Nov 16-21?

- The ALF will be hosted in two platforms: Zoom and Airmeeet. Monday to Friday smart talks will be broadcasted on [Airmeeet](#) twice daily at 11am and 8pm Singapore Time. In case you miss the sessions, a link to the recording will be sent to your email shortly after.
- On Saturday, the live Q&A and roundtable discussions will be hosted on Zoom, while the networking event will be hosted on Airmeeet. A link to both events will be sent to the Premium Pass holder.
- All registered attendees will receive detailed instructions via email.

2. Can the audiences ask questions to the speakers?

- Yes! On Saturday, Nov 21, the morning sessions on Zoom are reserved for live Q&A with the speakers. Please do take note that only Premium Pass holders have access to the live Q&A. For Basic Pass holders, you are free to post your questions on Airmeeet and we will try to share a Q&A report to all participants after the Forum.

3. When will the Networking Session start?

- The networking session will start right after the roundtable discussions. It will be hosted on Airmeeet. A detailed guide will be sent to all Premium Pass holders.

After The Forum

1. Will I receive certificates for the event?

- Yes! If you are a Premium Pass holder, you will receive an e-copy of a Certificate of Attendance signed by Harvard Faculty.

2. Will participants be able to get a recorded copy of the sessions?

- Yes! Participants will have on-demand access to recorded sessions for one year. Basic Pass holders will have access to all the smart talks recordings (Monday-Friday), while Premium Pass holders will have access to Saturday Q&A and roundtable discussions on top of all smart talk recordings. The access link will be provided to all participants after the Forum.

3. Due to unforeseen circumstances, I can't make it to the forum. Do you offer refunds?

- All cancellation requests must be made in writing to alf@asialeadership.org prior to program commencement to receive a refund subject to the following conditions: a. Less than 21 days prior to program commencement – 50% refund. b. Less than 14 days prior to program commencement – no refund, substitution is allowed provided CAL is notified in writing over email to alf@asialeadership.org with the heading "Substitution - Asia Leadership Forum". Please note that any refunds will be processed within 60-days after the Asia Leadership Forum.
